

## Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline



## **APPLICATION FORM**

HB 2930 (2021) established the Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline (Commission). The commission will utilize an open hearing process, including public notice, public outreach, and public hearings to develop rules establishing uniform standards of conduct and discipline for law enforcement officers. The initial rules must be adopted and published by October 1, 2022.

The commission will schedule frequent meetings to comply with the October 1, 2022, deadline. Commission business meetings will be hosted in Salem and commission members will be able to participate remotely by phone or computer. Commission public hearings may be held throughout the state. A member of the commission is entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in ORS 292.495. Note: All meetings are public meetings.
